



St. Petersburg Elks Lodge 1224 has earned the distinct honor of being recognized by Grand Lodge as the 1st Place Winner for the 2019- 2020 All American Lodge Division V (1101-1500 membership). All American Lodges are selected in six divisions based upon membership size.

All American Lodge is the highest honor a lodge can receive according to current Lodge Exalter Ruler Doc Cook. The lodge will be recognized with the 1st Place All American Lodge Division V Plaque. The distinction was earned during the year PER Dawn Lieber served as Lodge Exalted Ruler.

To earn All American Lodge honors, a lodge and its members must demonstrate their commitment to the various programs of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks amongst other criteria. St. Petersburg Elks Lodge 1224 accomplished this thanks to a dedicated team of officers, committee members and most importantly, its volunteers and membership. ER, Doc Cook wishes to give a special thanks and shout out to AA Lodge Committee Members Dawn Lieber PER, Rudy Masi, Sr. FSEA President, Toni Goodrich PDD, and May Graci. 




