I told the veteran that I would be out on the 26th to help all of the vets at that time that needed things. At 9am they were at the office door (17 of them) and very happy to receive the items that we elks donate thru our lodges to help our needy veterans.

Being a veteran myself that went thru programs back in 1994 understand and will do what I can for our veterans. I also delivered 500 backpacks that our lodge was able to get with one of our grants thru Grand Lodge.
