

The lodge waived all its pool fees for non-members/large groups, as well as donating a large case of cold water for the attendees.

We Rock the Spectrum Kids Gym in Clearwater was founded to provide a place for children of all ability levels to play and grow together. Their staff and volunteers' goal is to aid children with special needs in growing beyond the expectations of doctors and therapists.

The Kind Mouse - is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization based in St. Petersburg, that assists families and children in Pinellas County with food insecurities and chronic hunger.
